Village Field report

Maintenance

The work that was started earlier in the year to push back encroaching vegetation has continued over the Spring and Summer months. Over 100 hours of volunteer help have been recorded. Thank you to all those people who have given time, as volunteers, to the work.

With dry, summer conditions it was decided to contract Wold Tree Services to chip the brash that had been cleared from the perimeter. Help was also required for the removal of underground concrete blocks that had supported the wooden play equipment, and a digger was hired. At the same time tree roots were dug out and soil moved, levelling and improving the perimeter close to the bordering ditch.

Remaining work for the coming few months includes rotovating the soil that has been moved by the digger and, if possible, grass seeding and bulb planting. Quotes for the pathway into the lower field and car park entrance are also being sought. We may also be including some fencing work.

Play Equipment

A decision was made earlier this year to remove the remaining wooden play equipment from the field due to its deteriorating condition. The remaining equipment was inspected in August by a ROSPA Play Equipment Inspector and continues to be available for all to enjoy.

Update from the Upper Field Working Party

The working party has met on a number of occasions throughout the year. In addition, several members attended a Grant evening hosted by WLDC. We had a great response from residents to the survey. Using the survey/consultation results, the working party has approached play equipment companies for quotes and draft plans. Our aim is to improve the facilities on the field, focusing on improving access, sitting areas, play equipment for children of all ages and abilities as well as introducing some gym equipment suitable for adults. We will be applying for grants to enable us to do this.

All residents of both Claxby and Normanby were invited to drop-in sessions which were held in the Village Hall on 31st August to view our progress and to make observations. Thank you to those who called in.

All comments will be carefully considered as we work towards a final plan for the upper field. Please get in touch with Judith Pilbrow if you missed the drop-in sessions and would like to know more.

Dog walkers

Dog walkers have noted that some people are not picking up after their dog. Please do so, whether on footpaths or in the dog walking field. Always take poo bags with you. There are many bins around the village for disposal.

Claxby Community Choir

Formed in 2019, with around 20 singers, membership has now grown to 50. In consequence, the choir is now too large to rehearse in Claxby village hall, so has moved rehearsals to Osgodby.

The choir has a full programme of concerts for the coming year. After the hugely successful concert at Market Rasen Methodist Church, the choir has been invited by Cllr Stephen Bunney to perform at the West Lindsey District Carol Service on Friday 8th December 2023, again at the Methodist church, with a return visit to the church planned for a summer concert on 29th June 2024.

Other concerts include Wednesday 8th November in Nettleton Village Hall and a Carol Concert on Friday 15th December at 6.30pm in St Mary's Church, Claxby.
