Community Field

The bulbs which were planted by volunteers last year are popping up in some of the shaded areas of the field. Spring is not far away!

Once the weather improves the newly purchased inclusive picnic tables and seat will be allocated their places in the field in readiness for warmer days and picnic time.

With improved access, together with our car park facility, there will be something for all members of the community to enjoy. Views over to Lincoln Cathedral or up to the Wolds are great from the field. We can recommend the blue swing for some relaxing viewing. \odot The new play equipment is providing fun and challenges to the younger members of our community. Community Field Sign To comply with legal requirements, under the Occupiers Liability Act 1957, 1984, we have purchased a sign for the field. It will be installed as the weather improves. Villagers are reminded that, in the play area, adult supervision is required at all times.

Car Park is currently opened for events in the Village Hall and Community Field and can be be booked by villagers or walking groups. Feedback regarding locking the gate supported adding a combination lock on the top gate with villagers having access to the code and locking the bottom gate to prevent vehicle access to the rest of the field, work to be carried out when the weather improves.

Dog Walking Area The fencing in the dog walking area has been upgraded and it's great to see so many members of the community using the facility with their dogs. A polite reminder that dogs are not allowed in the upper field and thank you to those dog owners who are keeping the dog walking facility so clean. Please continue to be vigilant, particularly if you exercise your dog off lead to "pick up" and bin to comply with legislation.

Footpath Mulberry Road

Work to remove overgrown vegetation from the footpath from Bristow's corner to the telephone box along Mulberry Road has been carried out, improving safety for pedestrians.

Village Hall

Volunteers continue with improvements and maintenance.

It was resolved at the February PC Meeting to continue with free use of the hall for residents as income from the hire of the hall is meeting the current running costs. Donations, however, are always appreciated to help towards heating costs, particularly in the winter months.

Money raised at village hall events was used to purchase material for new tablecloths which Charles Blake kindly volunteered to make free of charge. These, together with some bunting also made by Charles, are now in the village hall and are in regular use.

Bulb Planting

The Parish Clerk was once again successful in obtaining free daffodil and "Star of Bethlehem" bulbs from MR Rotary Club. These had been donated from a large nursery in the Netherlands as "surplus to requirement". They were packaged into approximately 2Kg bags and distributed to residents of both Claxby and Normanby. There are signs that shoots are already appearing from some of these bulbs and it is hoped that the blooms will enhance the village environment.
